




Impact of COVID on Payroll Jobs Index by Illawarra SA4 Region to 11 September









Speed of Recovery & Distance from pre-COVID Employment Levels
(4 April – 5 June 2021. Balloon size indicates regional value-add by segment. Scaled)







Jobs Impact by Age (Australia)







COVID-19 Impact on Jobs by Sector & Gender - NSW (11 September 2021 data)






Payroll Impact Overall & by Gender - NSW

Illawarra & NSW - Comparison by Business Size (No. of Businesses)




Illawarra vs. NSW Comparison of Sectors by Business Size (% of businesses)

(LH Bars=Illawarra: RH Bars=NSW)






Employment Impact by Business Size - NSW






Impact on Commuting Habits
